Shoebill stork

A shoebill stork's lifespan is up to 35 years. Their height is around 3.5-4.5 ft! Females weigh 11 pounds, and males weigh 12 pounds. That is about as heavy as a gallon of paint or a full-grown cat. Their wingspan is 8 feet! Their big beak is 7 inches long. Their color can be blue-gray, slate color, and dark grey. The creepy, human eyes of a shoebill stork can be yellowish or grayish-white. They're from the swamps and wetlands of Central and East Africa. Heat is a threat to the eggs and their young. Their big bill is like a canteen showering water all

over the nest. Lungfish, Catfish, Tilapia, water snakes, frogs, monitor lizards, and young turtles may serve as snacks or meals.



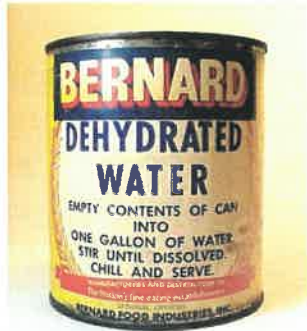
Dugong
